Community Emergency Response Team Basic Course

Prince George County Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Basic CERT class announcement!

CERT educates individuals about disaster preparedness for hazards that may impact their area and trains them in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. Using training learned in the classroom and during exercises, CERT volunteers can assist others in their community following a disaster when professional responders are not immediately available to help. CERT volunteers are also encouraged to support emergency response agencies by taking an active role in emergency preparedness projects. CERT allows you to meet new people, learn new skills and become a valuable asset to your community.

Prince George CERT will be holding basic CERT training starting on **September 14th, 2023**. Classes will be nine consecutive **Thursdays from 6:00 – 9:00 pm**.
