The June 21st meeting was eventful. President Cynthia had to navigate a detour due to a major traffic tie up on the interstate, member Michael Moore and his wife, Susan, joined us in person from Melbourne, Australia, and after officially waiving the 10-day notice requirement, the club approved bylaws amendments.

After a Happy Dollars and announcements, Katie Harlow introduced our speaker for the day, her colleague and fellow Prince George Rotarian, Lili Quintana. Lili related that she was born in Connecticut, but moved to Hopewell with her parents who were establishing a ministry in the area. Lili described her experiences tutoring students while she was still in high school and that service has always been a string passion of hers. Though ultimately accepted at a number of universities, she traveled to Puerto Rico to attend the Inter American University. Though her parents were from Puerto Rico originally, Lili faced challenges studying in a country she wasn't familiar with and was so far away from her parents. After university, she volunteered, then worked at the Hopewell Housing Redevelopment Authority. Though very committed to the work, she felt she still needed to find her passion. That is when she applied for a job at a crisis hotline operated by The James House. Her passion of serving people had been found. The rest they say, is her story.

After Lili's presentation, we noted the donated items that Rotarians had brought to the meeting which were going to be presented by Donna and others after the meeting. We collect seasonal items for the summer and later for the winter for the Community Health Center staff to distribute to those patients who may benefit from certain items.

The daily drawing benefited Michael Moore with \$7. The big pot was not drawn, so the money collected at the meeting will be added to \$91 already collected.
