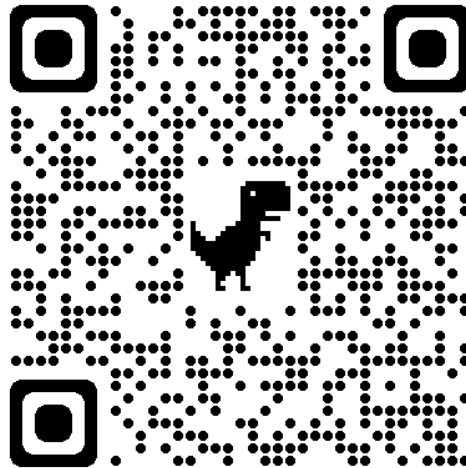

Sasha Reynolds, Club Youth Services Chair, and Brian Manning, Club President, attended the Prince George High School Student orientation during which students and their parents had the opportunity to visit all the extracurricular clubs and activities offered to students at the school. Sasha reports that about 50 students have expressed an interest in participating in Interact, which is Rotary's chartered public school level affiliate chartered organization. She expects this number to decrease as there are many school organizations competing for interested students.



Sasha and Brian were on the Rotary Open Mic and noted that they stood back, and the returning Interactors described the activities and advantages Interact membership provides for their members. RYLA (Rotary Youth Leadership Awards) was a hot topic in the discussions. This leadership training conference every year over the President's Day holiday, is a sought out experience. This peer-led conference focuses on leadership, conflict resolution, project planning, and other topics.

Traditionally, the club has sponsored three Interact delegates to the conference. This year the price is rising to \$275 per delegate. In February 2024, we had 3 Interact delegates and two group leaders (for which there is no charge). The club will

explore increasing the number of delegates the club will sponsor.
