

Scott Reiter, the Agriculture and Natural Resources Extension Agent for Virginia Cooperative Extension for Prince George County, will speak to the club on the 18th.. He has served PG for 17 years with 7 years in Campbell County. His time is split between commercial agriculture and home horticulture & Master Gardener programs. He is an area native growing up on a Dinwiddie County farm where he lives today.

The title of his presentation will be: Are native plants the answer to common landscape issues?

He described a number of services offered by ARLS currently, as well as services to which the system is aspiring, funding, space, and personnel allowing. Everyone knows there are books, periodicals, digital media, and computers available at the library. What many don't know about other services, such as family craft nights, exercise classes, free rental of disc golf kits, access to streaming shows and electronic books, and excellent programming such as speakers and events.
