It worked perfectly on the way to the Food Pantry, but when Carol and Cynthia got into the car for the delivery journey, it was blowing cool on the driver's side and warm on the passenger side. Poor Cynthia. We made the decision to roll down a couple of windows and enjoy the fresh air.

Cynthia was the navigator, and we shared the actual carrying of the meals to the doors, more or less. We were always greeted warmly and politely.

### Important Delivery Information to Share:

1. When you pick up your meals get the "green cards" to leave at the doors of homes where no one answers the door. Do not leave the meal, but call the FeedMore phone number on the green sheet to advise of the route and the lack of delivery. FeedMore will make arrangements to leave a meal later. DO NOT leave the meal. DO NOT return the meal to the Food Pantry. Dispose of the meal.



OK, now on with the story. After our deliveries, Cynthia and I took the opportunity to have lunch and share life stories. Cynthia is a country girl at heart and has her own garden on family land in Dinwiddie County. Ask her about it sometime. Anyway, this country girl presented Carol with a jar of muscadine jelly which she had made herself from muscadines picked from her land.

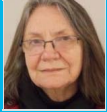

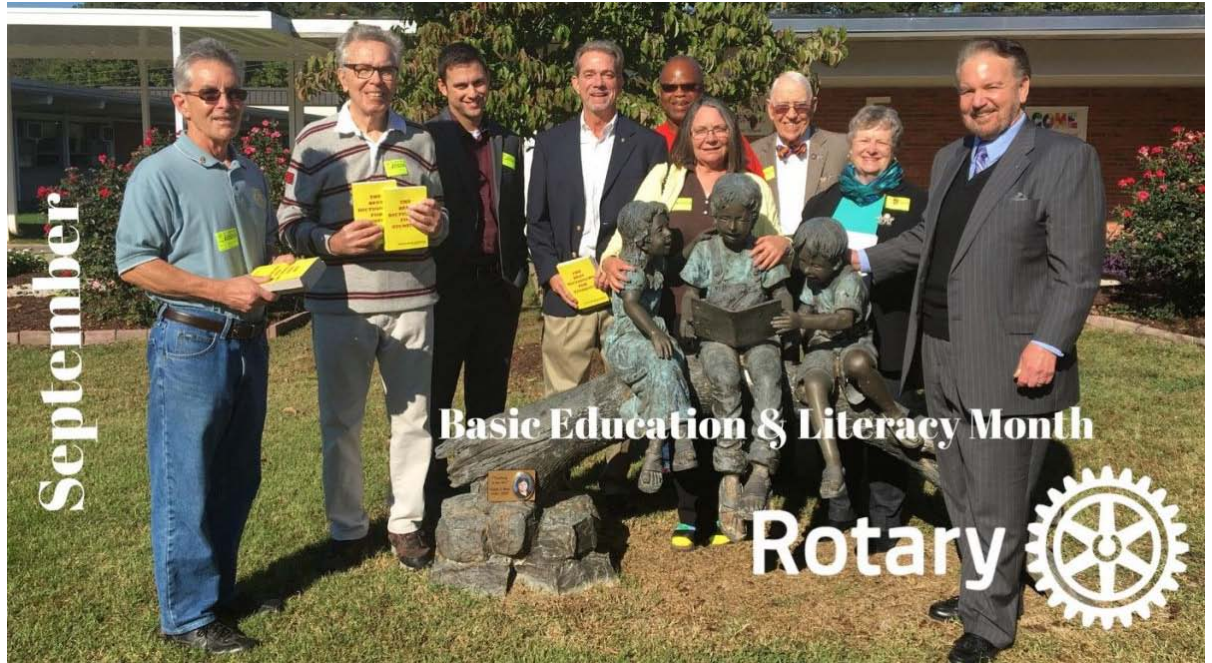
