Last Week's Highlights

- Last week, our speaker was Frank Nanney giving us a brief history of our club's 1st 20 years. Frank is shown below with meeting chair Lisa Clary. On January 12, 1928 members of the Petersburg Rotary Club came to South Hill to determine interest in a new club. After finding interest, on May 4th 5 members from Petersburg came to South Hill and signed up 22 men of which 2 were Frank's father and uncle. After electing their officers the club set up Friday evening supper meetings on Fridays at the Lincoln Hotel. They received their formal Club Charter on August 10. Frank gave us several of the next 20 years. In 1930 they held the first minstrel show to provide playground equipment for the school. In 1931 the club made history with 100% attendance for the month and largest increase in membership in Virginia. In 1932 Frank's uncle became club president and they began inviting 2 high school students to a meeting each month. In 1937 they voted to sponsor a Boy Scout troop with 2 members as leaders and Frank's father became President. In 1941-1942 several members of the club resigned to join the military. 20 members of the club attended a dinner at Ft. Pickett in 1942 to thank the club for fund raising to build a recreation room. The club hosted a bingo party in 1945 at Camp Pickett Hospital for convalescent patients. Additional playground equipment was installed at South Hill High School in 1946. In 1947 the club sponsored a men's beauty contest with 700 attendees.
- Members voted to approve a \$100 donation to the American Legion for their veterans support activities.
