TUTU Desk update

Tutudesk Update


As of July 2, we are happy to announce that District 7600 has collected \$7900 towards the Tutu Desk Campaign, well surpassing the goal of \$5,000. This will provide 395 Tutudesks to children in Africa. Of the total dollars raised, Warwick at City Center raised \$660, providing 33 desks and our Change for Change Pig bought 10 more.

The Tutudesk Campaign was started by Archbishop Desmond Tutu and has continued under the leadership of his daughter, Thandeka Tutu-Gxashe with the key mission to provide 20 million Tutudesks to African fjsldkjflsdkfjn school children by 2025. An estimated 95+ million children in sub-Saharan Africa are affected by classroom desk shortages, which has a direct, ongoing, and extremely negative impact on the development of the child's literacy development and academic performance. Tutudesk provides children in need with a mobile, steady and stable desk enabling an immediate, lasting and positive impact on the beneficiary child's literacy development and overall academic performance.

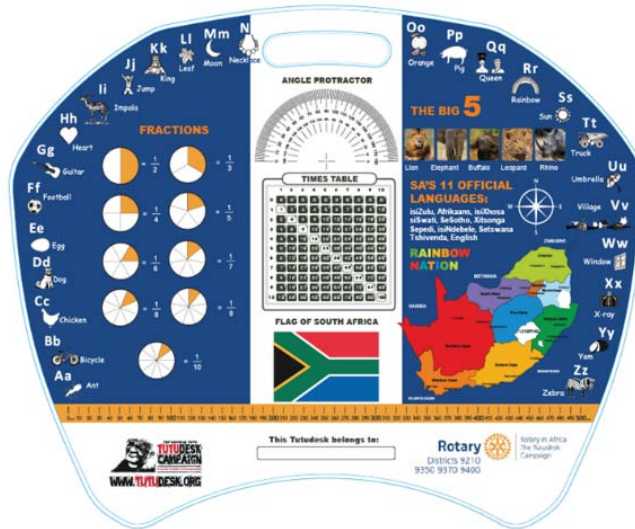
