We will distribute approximately 75,000 cases of cookies, which equates to 900,000 boxes of cookies to more than 680 troops across the three delivery locations!

 - Able to lift at least 30lbs.
 - Able to be on their feet for at least 3 hours.

Volunteers will be assigned as a **Counter/Loader** – loading and counting cases of cookies into volunteer vehicles.


