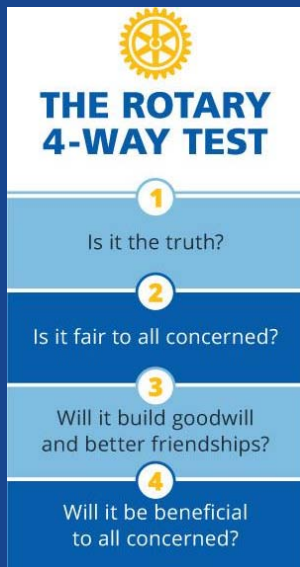

Speakers for June 18th: Shauntrice Williams, Habitat for Humanity Peninsula & Greater Williamsburg

is Ms.

Shauntrice Williams, Chief Executive Officer for Habitat for Humanity on the Peninsula and Greater Williamsburg area. Ms. Williams, an experienced leader in nonprofit management and community development, began her new role on November 12, 2024.

Ms. Williams has dedicated her career to improving communities and empowering underserved populations. Her commitment to affordable housing and her strategic vision align well with Habitat for Humanity's mission to bring people together to build homes, communities and hope. Ms. Williams joins Habitat for Humanity Peninsula and Greater Williamsburg from the YMCA of the Virginia Peninsulas. There, she most recently served as Group Vice President leading the operations, strategy and growth of five branches with a total budget of \$9.4 million. Prior to her leadership roles at the YMCA, Ms. Williams spent nearly 13 years at the Salvation Army as a Corps Officer and Executive Director managing all operations for locations in five cities along the east coast.

As CEO of Habitat for Humanity Peninsula and Greater Williamsburg, Ms. Williams oversees all aspects of the organization's regional operations, including the Habitat ReStores in Newport News, Williamsburg and Yorktown, as well as ongoing homebuilding and repair projects, and community outreach initiatives.

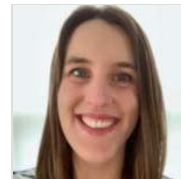

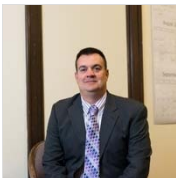

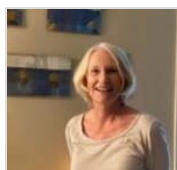
