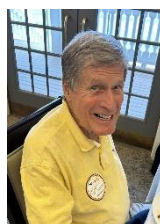

More than US\$4 million funds water, education, agriculture supplies, and equipment for affected communities

The relief efforts and funding Rotary provided after last year's devastating earthquake in Turkey and Syria show that Rotary members create hope where it is needed, said outgoing RI President R. Gordon R. McNally during a recent visit to Turkey.

"Having met the Rotary members in Hatay province, Turkey, I know that they will [continue to] be there to help rebuild their community," McNally said while visiting affected areas in April. Among many stops, he toured a kindergarten and a vocational school that Rotary members resupplied and a mobile kitchen and bakery they outfitted. "I thank Rotary members for helping Create Hope in the World for those so badly affected by the disaster," McNally added, referencing his presidential theme.

--July 25.2000- A Concorde supersonic airplane—Air France flight 4590—crashed outside Paris, killing all 109 people on board and four others on the ground; the event was believed to have hastened the end of all Concorde operations three years later.
