Important Update - District Training Assembly

District 7610 Training

The District Training Assembly (DTA) is Saturday, May 4, from 8:30 until 3:15 at the University of Mary Washington Stafford Campus in Fredericksburg. The District Team Training Seminar (DTTS) training program also runs concurrently on the same date. The DTA program schedule is shown below.

DTA is the final training offered for President-Elects and their leadership team before the new Rotary year begins on July 1. We urge you to register now. There will be individual sessions for Secretary-Elects, Treasurer-Elects and Foundation Chairs. The cost is \$45 for each attendee and includes continental breakfast and a buffet lunch, plus almost continuous coffee and free parking. Registration is open for the Sterling event on May 18th! Visit www.soundthealarm.org to register today and commit to joining 35,000 volunteers across the country to make homes safer by installing smoke alarms, replacing alarm batteries and helping families create escape plans.

Join us on Saturday, May 18th to help Sound the Alarm and Save a Life. Everyone should arrive by 8 a.m. at the Sterling United Methodist Church located at 304 E Church Rd, Sterling, VA 20164. Onsite training will be provided over breakfast by someone from the Loudoun County Fire Marshal's office. We will also send all participants videos to watch prior to your arrival.

There are essentially 3 volunteer roles that day (videos on each role is also sent several days before the event to educate everyone on all 3 roles):

1. Installer ♦ the person installing the smoke alarms
2. Educator ♦ the person providing home fire education material to residents
3. Documenter ♦ the person documenting what was present in the home before we arrived (i.e. # of existing smoke alarms, how many not working, etc.) and what we did while there.
