**Today's Program** – We are pleased to have **Rotarian Michael, Assistant Governor, Area 10, District 7610,** as our speaker today. Michael has been a Rotarian since 2006 and is currently a member of the McLean Club. He is a Past President and currently Club Treasurer. Previously, he was a member of the Rotary Clubs of Kigali, Rwanda and of Ewell in the U.K.

He has been Assistant Governor for Area 10 for three years. He regularly visits Clubs in the Area as liaison between the District and the Clubs. His role is to support each Club by identifying District resources that can help Clubs meet their goals and overcome challenges.

Michael is a retired Foreign Service Office after working for 35 years in the Department of State. He has worked at U.S. Embassies around the world, including in Iran, Australia, Sweden, Geneva, and Zambia. He was the American Ambassador to Rwanda from 2005-2008.

The Rotary Club of Commerce (Texas) had one Rotarian compete in this year's Olympic games in Paris. Rotarian Joseph Brown, age 28, competed in the Men's Discus Throw. At Olympic Trials in June, Joseph finished in the top three, earning his way to the Olympic games in Paris.

Rotarian Dr. Martine Trunkenwald, President of the Rotary Club of Forbach (France) carried the torch at the 2024 Olympic Games.

Arshad Nadeem, age 27, has been appointed as the Ambassador of Rotary Pakistan after winning Pakistan's first-ever gold medal in an individual event. Arshad competed in the Javelin Throw and was supported by Rotary Pakistan. In his role as Ambassador, Arshad will inspire and mentor youth throughout Pakistan. Arshad is also receiving the 2024 Rotary Pakistan Nation Builders Award.
