AAC is **GRATEFUL for NEW or GENTLY USED ITEMS** --- so if you have been thinking about clearing out a closet or doing a donation run to the Salvation Army or Goodwill --- please consider AAC. If you know anyone downsizing or looking for an excuse to "Spring Clean," please share with them too!



Donations of the following still serviceable “stuff” is MOST welcome! (If in doubt, check with K directly)

- **Medical equipment** (e.g., wheelchairs, canes, walkers, crutches, boots, blood pressure cuffs, thermometers, "bathroom" scales, medical office items)
- **Lawn and gardening items** (e.g., lawn mowers, edging equipment, rakes, shovels) – **no electric items**
- **Tools** (e.g., hammers, screwdrivers, retractable measuring tapes) – no electric tools
- **Home and office furniture** (e.g., desks, file cabinets, chairs, bed, tables)
- **Clothing** for men, women, teens, children, and babies (e.g., jackets, scarves, gloves, dresses, shirts, pants, shorts, robes, socks, bras)
- **Shoes** for men, women, teens, and children (e.g., sneakers, dress shoes, sandals, boots)
- **Play items** for kids (e.g., toys, sport equipment, books, games, Crayons, markers, basketballs, baseballs, footballs)
- **Computers** (old functioning items are welcome - but **if non-functional or in need of repair, please do not donate**)
- **Kitchen items** (e.g., pots, pans) – **no electric appliances**
- **Hygiene items** (e.g., toothbrushes, bars of soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste)
