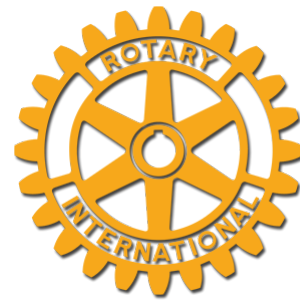

Mental Health Initiative Celebrations

It is getting more and more exciting to write these emails to you and the Rotary.

With the most recent donation of \$3,000 we were able to cover the cost of the following:

1. A mother and daughter who left an abusive relationship and stayed in a women's shelter & friends' home for 6 weeks so far. During this time, we have been able to see both of these ladies weekly as well as separate medication management appointments with our nurse practitioner! We are getting them tied in with Social Services and other

resources through the county and community. Huge success stories here clinically as well as life improvements/safety.

2. A teenage female discharged from an inpatient mental health facility after a suicide attempt. She has been seen weekly by a therapist for individual therapy and the family (2 parents and 1 daughter) is also seen by a different therapist for family therapy here at Acadian on a weekly basis. Again, another huge improvement in family life and short-term clinical outcomes.
3. A high school student referred to us from PCWS. This student had no ability to pay and was in desperate need of help. He has been seen weekly by a therapist for 5 weeks now and continues to heal.
4. A middle school female from Gainesville living with her grandmother and no ability to pay. She has been seen for 7 weeks now and is improving on a weekly basis. This young lady may be able to be discharged from our services soon due to her improvement!

Again, Chris, we are so blessed to have the ability to help these community members. We can do these missions because of groups of people like the Rotary Club! Thank you so much, from the bottom of my heart.

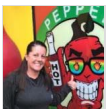

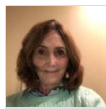
