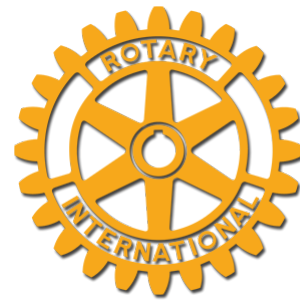

Volunteers removed all unwanted plants around the perimeter, built up the stone landscape edging around the perimeter, and applied linseed oil to the wood to preserve the frame.

Nadia provided the needed supplies, snacks, and water. Rotarians brought additional garden tools.

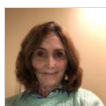
