Nicole has 18+ years experience covering a full spectrum of affordable housing and human services for homeless and vulnerable individuals and families throughout Northern Virginia. Nicole currently serves on the Inmed Partnerships for Children's Advisory board and as a member of the Loudoun Human Services Network. Nicole was inducted into the Virginia Housing Alliance's Top 40 Network in 2015 and has been actively involved in both Fairfax and Loudoun County's affordable housing and human services advocacy efforts. She previously served on the Loudoun County's Affordable Housing Advisory Board to mobilize business and community support to develop and sustain affordable housing.

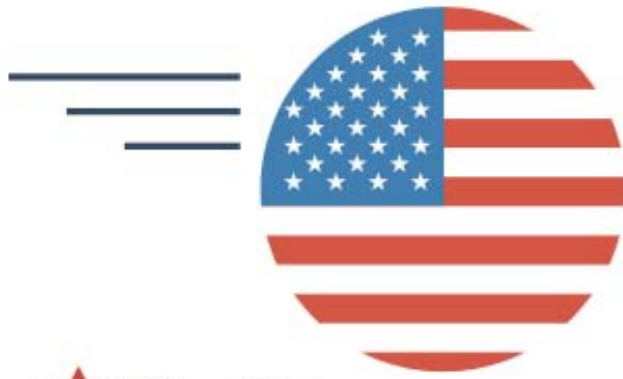

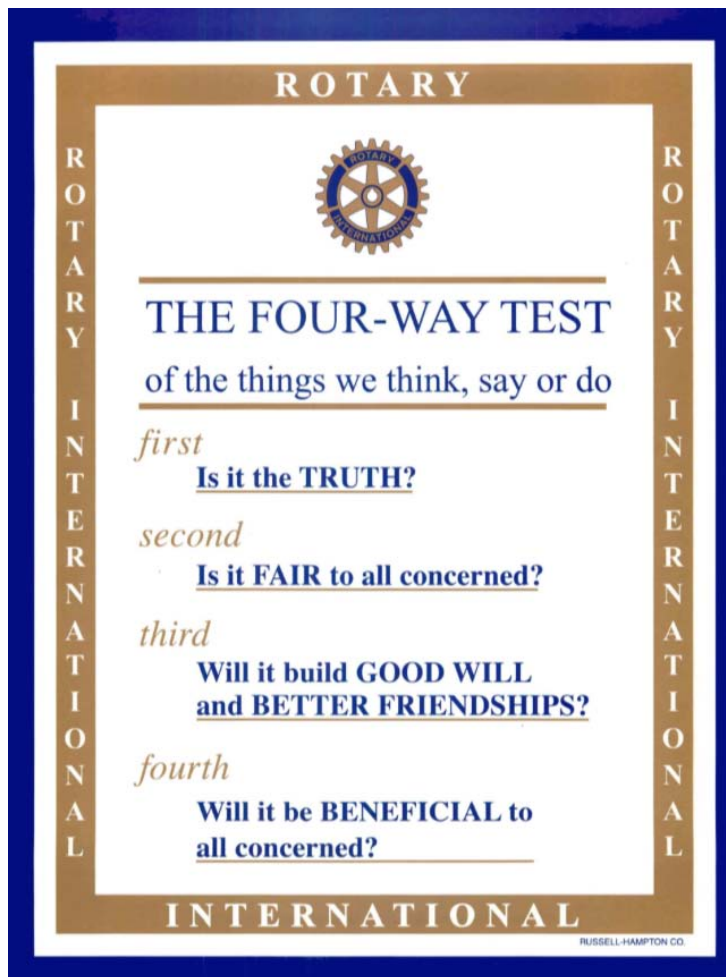
