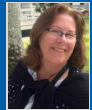

So let's track that service. That's what "Rotarian's Personal Service Project" is all about. E.G. - You decide to take a walk in Great Falls in pick up trash - Log the date and # of hours, You go and donate blood - Log that day & time. Also, you can log money, like kind money amount and mileage. If you have questions, please ask Connie Sawtell or June Kelley.
