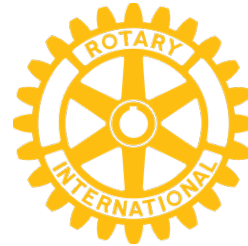

## JANUARY 15, 2023 MESSAGE FROM THE DISTRICT GOVERNOR

Dear Fellow Rotarians:
