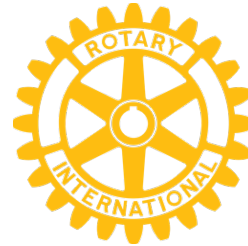

The first step in this tool is doing an audit of all of your club's online resources. Take some time now and review your social media, websites, cloud storage, email addresses, parade and community event displays etc. Review who is authorized to use everything AND to be sure that correct branding is consistent across all channels. We are not the logo police but want to be sure that all of our clubs use proper branding.
