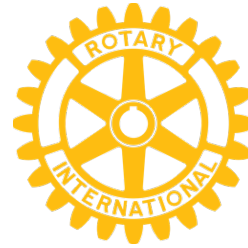

CONSIDERING FIREWORKS AS PART OF YOUR FUNDRAISER? READ THIS FIRST!

All U. S. Rotary Districts, Clubs, Rotaract Clubs, Club Rotary Foundations and pretty much any entity that is officially "Rotary" is covered for General Liability by the U. S. Rotary Club & District Liability Insurance Program. It is a very comprehensive blanket of coverage, **but there are several specific exclusions and/or exceptions.** Rotary District 7630 Insurance Representative, PDG Jim Roney, wants you to click "Read More" to find out the details about putting on fireworks shows at your fundraiser! One area that has garnered particular attention of our current insurer are clubs and districts that decide to **put on fireworks shows**, either as a community event or a fundraiser. New rules have been put in place that, if not adhered to, will leave the club or district uncovered and liable to claims for bodily injury and property damage.



If your club decides to hire a pyrotechnic vendor for a fireworks display, your club **must purchase a primary commercial general liability insurance policy with coverage limits of at least \$2 million** for the fireworks display. These special event policies are available from your local licensed insurance professionals. These policies are getting more expensive as time goes on.

Also, you must be sure that the pyrotechnics vendor has their own commercial general liability policy with coverage limits of at least \$5 million, or the limits required by the municipality or venue, whichever is more. Make sure that your club is named as an "additional insured on a primary and noncontributory basis" on the vendor's policy and they provide you with a Certificate of Insurance to verify.

Once you have all of this in place, the club must still notify RI's Risk Management Department of the event and supply them with copies of your policy and the vendor's COI for their approval.

Even with all this, the U. S. Club Program's insurance will be excess over your club's policy in the event of a loss. Your policy will pay first, and if the limits are exhausted with claim payments, then the Program's limits will kick in.

Note that this only applies if your club signs the pyrotechnic vendor's contract. If you are only contributing funds to a fireworks display, or adding your club as an event sponsor, no additional insurance needs to be purchased by the club. However, you should still get added to the vendor's policy as an additional insured and get a certificate of insurance just for good measure.
