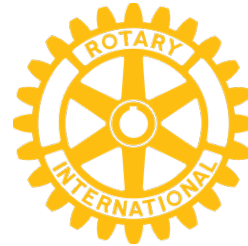

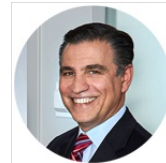

ROTARY CLUB OF SALISBURY DISTRIBUTES GOLF PROCEEDS AND SEEKS SPONSORS!

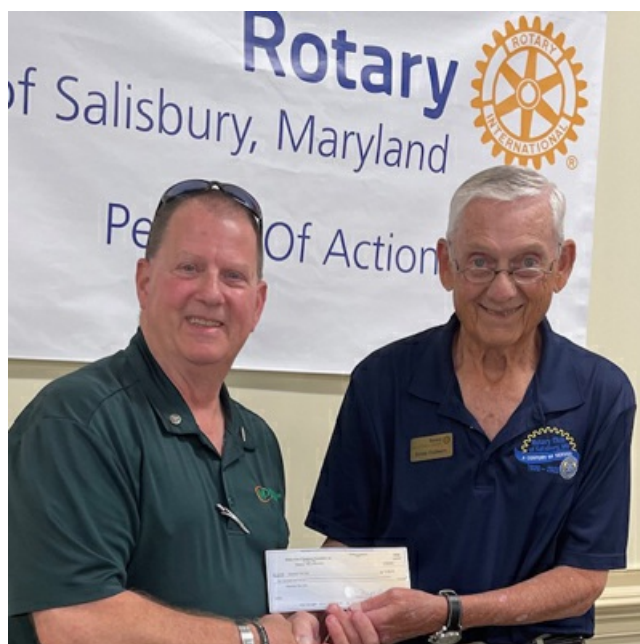

\$23,500 IN NANTICOKE ROTARY FOUNDATION GRANTS AWARDED



At its installation dinner and meeting to recognize new officers of the Nanticoke Rotary, the annual distribution of the club's foundation grants was also made. The organizations receiving the grants are groups that provide services to families and/or children and youth. A total of \$23,500 was provided by Nanticoke Rotary to assist these groups in their community efforts.

The recipients were:

--Love Inc is a leader in Sussex County providing support and resources to the homeless and to other vulnerable populations.

--Seaford Swimming Pool Association provides family and youth recreational activities, including therapy programs for special need students. The Rotary funds received will be used towards a rehabilitation project to update the facility and improve the handicapped entrance.

--Boys and Girls Club of Delaware will use the funds received for part of their Summer Fun Club.

--ARK Educational Resource Center was granted funds to use toward educational materials and mentoring students in Math and English.

--Bridgeville Public Library was granted funds to support a ten-week summer reading program.

--Nanticoke River Arts Council will use the funds given to them to purchase supplies for their Children's Art classes.

Nanticoke Rotary of Seaford and Laurel is a service organization whose purpose is to enhance families, children, and youth experiences in our community. Nanticoke Rotary is part of an international club of over 1.1 members. Local members meet twice a month at noon at Grotto Pizza for discussion, networking, planning, and learning from speakers about local organizations and businesses.
