### What You Missed ...

Last week,

we welcomed Steve Sinko, the President of Move 2 IncluDE, a non-profit organization which provides adaptive wheelchairs for anyone with a disability that prevents them from completing a race on their own. He brought Preston, his favorite running companion, and talked about how he was inspired by Team Hoyt to begin this movement. Steve believes in inclusion through the movement of running, taking Preston, or anyone else willing to ride, through the journey of completing a 5K, 10K, or even the Boston Marathon! His organization has received donations to build 11 adaptive chairs, which he takes to local races and even elementary schools, so that kids can participate in field day.

Steve is a personal trainer by trade and life-long runner, but he has found the bond that develops when completing a race by pushing someone in the chair extends way beyond just being a client. He has a different perspective now, he says, "I'm not chasing a PR any more. There is a different energy looking at the person in the chair while running ... we're better when we do things together." He wants to open people's eyes at races and let them know that this opportunity exists.
