What You Missed ...

Last week, we heard about the many interesting programs offered by the University of Maryland Extension from Doris Behnke, friend of Missy Reynolds and long-time resident of North East. In 1862, the Morrill Land-Grant Act was passed into law and established the national Land-Grant University System, making higher education

accessible to the average citizen in every state. Maryland's land-grant college later became the University of Maryland and now has offices in 23 counties and Baltimore City which offer educational programs adapted to the needs and interests of local residents. This organization of educators turn "cutting-edge research into practical uses that improve lives of people all across Maryland."

One of the most popular programs is 4-H. Youth ages 5-18 can participate in a variety of clubs which help them reach their full potential by

developing essential life skills like decision-making, creative thinking, communications, and getting along with others, as well as many more.



Not a *youth* anymore? The Extension also offers programs in Financial Literacy, Water Quality and Quantity, Workforce Development, Health and Wellness, Home Gardening, Tourism, various environmental topics, Urban Affairs, and others.



Their Master Gardners program trains citizens in horticulture who then volunteer to educate residents about safe, effective and sustainable horticultural practices that build healthy gardens, landscapes, and communities. There is also an "Ask Extension" [Google form](#), reviewed by a team of experts, which anyone can submit, to ask questions about gardening, insects, or other plant-related topics.
