What You Missed ...

This week, The Rotary Foundation representative Laurie Menzel spoke to the club about the various aspects of Foundation giving and hosted a fireside chat in the evening discussing Major Donor gifts. Laurie focuses her efforts on informing Rotarians in five districts about the "**why**" it is a great investment to give to The Rotary Foundation (TRF): *to enable Rotarians to do great work in the world!*

Rotary has been recognized for the last 14 years by Charity Navigator as a 4-star organization. This rating means that Rotary is trusted to invest your money wisely and uses the least amount possible on administrative costs. In fact, 91-92% of every dollar donated to TRF goes directly to programs!

The three fund branches of TRF are:

1. PolioPlus Fund - The six total partners making up the Global Polio Eradication Initiative have worked together to reduce Polio cases by 99%! There are only two countries where Polio is still endemic - Afghanistan and Pakistan. They immunize over 450 million children/yr, fund over 150,000 Polio workers/yr and provide continuing disease surveillance in over 70 countries!
2. Annual Fund - This is the primary funding source for grants and programs. Your contributions to the "Share" fund go to District Designated Funds, which come right back to our community for local grants like the one we are doing with Fair Hill and North East Elementary School.
3. Endowment Fund - This is the future of Rotary! There are multiple ways to leave a legacy with Rotary to help fund future projects. Last year alone, \$20 million in earnings from this fund went back into the Districts.
