Commissioner Jim Moran



Commissioner Jim Moran visited the club this morning and answered questions asked by our members.

*What is happening with the bridge?

The good news is that the ramp closures are working. The county is getting information from CHART, the map apps are updating and telling users to stay on 50 and this is helping cut down on the traffic on Route 18. The people who know about Route 18 still use it, but the traffic is less than before because of the ramp closures. Notifications of ramp closures are posted each week, so people heading east will already know on Friday which ramps will be

closed. If you want to go west on the bridge, on Sunday people are encouraged to travel before 8:30 amor after 3:30 pm.

- As for the bridge replacement plan, the project is in phase 2 of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process. This phase focuses on what kind of structure would best suit the project, (ie bridge, tunnel, etc.) and how much the project will cost. Current cost estimates for the bridge alone are about 5-6 billion dollars. There are 2 more years remaining for this phase. Overall, the project is about 8 years away from being completed.
- What happens to the Kent Narrows Bridge when the expansion and replacement of the Bay Bridge gets under way and lanes are added to 50/301? No clear answer to this. Many environmental issues will need to be looked at. To be determined: Is this part of the money that will be spent on the Bay Bridge project?
- Construction on the current bridge has fallen behind schedule. The plan was to utilize grates rather than the steel plates used previously. There was a design flaw with the grates which caused a major traffic problem on Mother's Day, so a new process had to be put in place. This will add time to the project. While the work is being done on the deck replacement, they are also widening the lanes a bit to allow for emergency vehicles to pass when necessary.
- Will there be a pedestrian walkway on the new bridge? Commissioner Moran expressed concern about jumpers and how to prevent that from happening. The addition of a pedestrian walkway ultimately depends on the money.

*What's happening with the old outlet property?

• The owner had brought forward a couple of proposals, the first of which had county approval, but the owner had backed away from that proposal. Subsequent proposals have had less approval.

*Can you talk a little bit about the comprehensive plan as it relates to the trails?

• Commissioner Moran is a big user of the trails. The county is working on extending the trail down Route 8. Would like to see an overpass from Terrapin Park to the Inn at Chesapeake Bay Beach. The county has applied for grant funds from Senator Cardin's office.

*General remarks

- There is a need for more engineers in the county. Every project needs an engineer to oversee it.
- The county is working on three major projects: the new Board of Education administration building, the new regional detention center, and the courthouse.
- The regional detention center will house people from Caroline, Kent and Queen Anne's counties, but Queen Anne's County will be the administrative entity.
