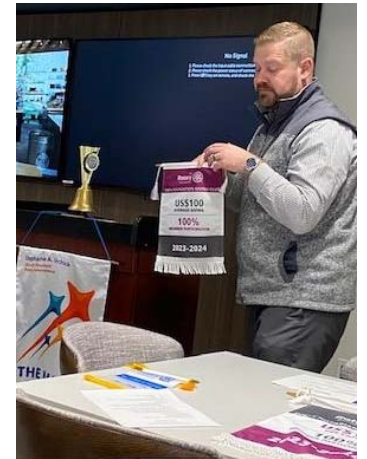
No coins? Don't worry, the buckets will accept cash and checks. Let's do our part to help find a cure for Alzheimer's.

They provide a prompt, sensitive, multiple agency response to child abuse so that every child / youth / teen and family can focus on healing. Since 1991, they have served thousands of children, averaging 120 new referrals each year.
