ROTARY PROJECTS AROUND THE WORLD - NIGERIA



Nigeria has one of the world's highest breast cancer mortality rates, a statistic that has not gone unnoticed by the Rotary Club of Ikoyi. "With an incredibly scary rise of the incidence of breast cancer in Nigeria, the club became saddled with the huge responsibility of combating this scourge with every resource available," says club member Winifred Ebiye Imbasi.

The club partnered with the Sarah Ayoka Oduwaiye Foundation to conduct free breast cancer screenings for more than 500 women at Lagos Island General Hospital in July 2023 and for 400 women in the neighborhood of Obalende in December. In January, the club held a Jazz Nite concert and awards ceremony at the Alliance Française theater to raise awareness.
