Blue Ridge Honor Flight

Marybeth Burns, a member of the Rotary Club of Hendersonville, spoke this week about the Blue Ridge Honor Flight program. The idea started with Earl Morse, a physician's assistant in Ohio looking for a way to honor a few patients who were WWII vets by flying them to DC to see the war memorials. In 2007, local businessman Jeff Miller, who had an uncle die in WWII and a father who was a vet, built on Morse's vision.



Miller started a program to fly local WWII veterans to DC to see the war memorials. At that time it was called HonorAir. Marybeth has been involved helping Jeff with the program since early on. The program has since expanded and there are now hubs in 44 states. Veterans (including Korea and Vietnam) are flown to DC, greeted at the airport, taken to the war memorials and Arlington Cemetery, and then greeted at the Asheville airport upon returning. They pay nothing and guardians pay \$400 to participate in the program as volunteer "chaperones." There are no paid employees for the organization, and all expenses are covered by donations. Assistant Governor Visit-Ken Shull

DG Tiffany Ervin has asked all assistant governors to visit each club in the district during July to present an "official visit" and share district goals and important information. We were privileged to have our AG and DGN Ken Shull visit Monday and present this year's Rotary theme banner **Rotary Connects The World** to PE Chris Johnson. Ken shared DG Tiffany's district theme **Southern Fried Rotary** and explained we show southern hospitality and service and are welcoming to all. He unveiled the new **Southern Fried Rotary Pin** that will be awarded by our Governor to those who do 4 of the 5

following items this year: sponsor a new member, donate \$25 or more to the Foundation, participate in a service project, attend a district event and visit another club. Anyone who attended the "Southern Shindig" district officers' installation in June can already check off one item!

He says the Rotary Vision statement succinctly expresses our Rotary "why" (Together we see a world where people unite and take action to create lasting change-across the globe, in our communities, and in ourselves). Ken shared DG Tiffany's two goals: 1- to have fun and 2- to do good in the world. He challenged all to participate, to **think outside the box** and then shared "there is no box!" so don't be constrained by "the way we've always done it."

Ken announced a district 7670 **Cinderella Project** where we provide shoes to some needed group in our community - it could Special Needs athletic shoes, firemen boots, prom shoes, etc. Our club will need a "chairman" to select our community project and lead the way. Ken spoke about a cruise to be held Feb. 2-9 out of Miami, 7 days on the Norwegian Encore, which will be a fundraiser for PolioPlus. Anyone can participate (not just Rotarians) and \$100 per person will be donated to The Rotary Foundation for polio eradication!
