We were happy to welcome Laura Jeffords, Executive Director of the **Mediation Center of WNC.** The Mediation Center is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization serving Buncombe, Henderson, Transylvania and Polk Counties whose mission is to  $\hat{a}\varepsilon$ ecreate Opportunity From Conflict $\hat{e}$ .

Since 1984, they have served WNC with conflict resolution service. Specifically, The Mediation Center offers family visitation, mediation, youth conflict resolution and other professional development training to attorneys, mediators, mental health professionals and community leaders.

Laura shared they are always looking for more volunteers and would welcome involvement by Rotarians.

For those who may not have known previously, our club once sponsored Jan Woloson from the Mediation Center as a "Rotary Peace Fellow" in Thailand.
