## Stormwater Div-City of Hendersonville

We were pleased to have Michael Huffman from the City of Hendersonville join us to kick off Rotary's recognition of Water and Sanitation Month. He shared that his job is to make sure the City is compliant with the permit that allows municipalities to discharge storm water, which is the number one source of water pollution in the US.

Michael shared 6 minimum control measures that communities like ours need to implement to educate and reduce pollution:

- 1-Community education & outreach
- 2-Public education & involvement
- 3-Post construction storm water management
- 4-Food, housekeeping and storm water retention (inspections/street sweeping)
- 5-Erosion & sediment control
- 6-Elicit discharge protection & inspection

It was a fascinating program and we appreciated his time.
