Wild Polio Virus Summary:

The number of wild polio cases for **2024** has increased as of November 6, 2024 - the new total is **68**. There have been 45 in Pakistan and 23 in Afghanistan.

The total number of wild polio cases for **2023** were **12**

The total number of wild polio cases in **2022** were **30**.

The total number of wild polio cases in **2021** were **6**.

The total number of wild polio cases in **2020** were **140**.
