Sheriff Don Brown and Captain Jeff Eddins will present an enlightening program on our County's Narcotics Division.

Rotarian Don Brown began his law enforcement career in 1988 as an Officer with the Newton Police Department. He has served as Officer, Sergeant, Criminal Investigations Division Sergeant, Lieutenant, Captain and became the Chief of Police of Newton in 2008. Brown was elected Catawba County Sheriff in 2018 after serving with the city of Newton Police Department for 30 years and retiring after ten years as Police Chief. Sheriff Brown believes strongly in developing relationships and partnerships between law enforcement and the community.

Captain Jeff Eddins is experienced as Narcotics, Special Enforcement Group, Canines and Drones. He is a member of the Sheriff's Command staff. Captain Eddins is an investigator/manager with exemplary investigative achievement in criminal investigations, conspiracy investigations, officer involved shooting investigations, homicide investigations, background investigations, OCDETF investigations, asset forfeiture investigations and operations requiring physical security, surveillance and counter-surveillance.
