Orders can also be placed and paid for by calling 586-3555 and telling the Mad Batter staff it is for Rotary Thursday. It is also possible to order on Thursday. Food ordered that day would need to be picked up at Mad Batter. Thank you very, very much to Mad Batter for working to make these food options available. The club will provide bottled water. It is not necessary to order food to join us.

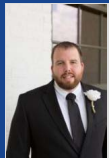
