Little Library Repair

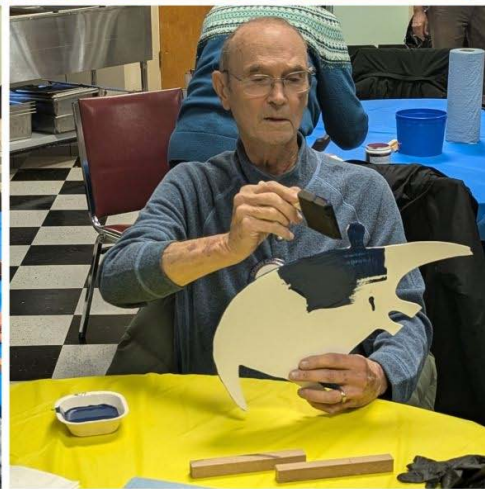

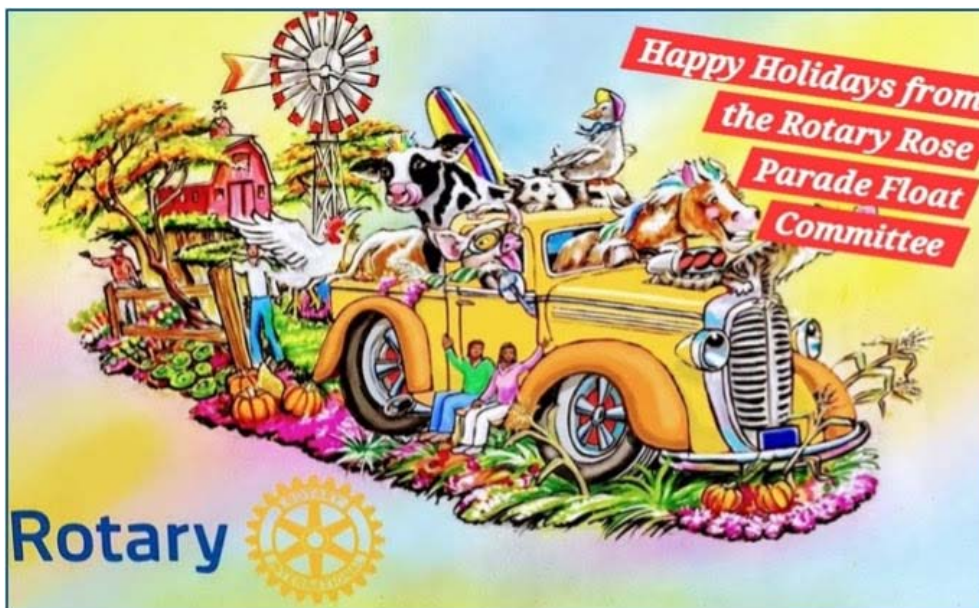
