Miller Speaks About St. Luke's Hospital



At last week's meeting, Bill Miller spoke to the Club about the future of St. Luke's Hospital. Bill serves on the Hospital's Board of Trustees as both the Board Chair and Treasurer. He has been very involved with the transition coming to St. Luke's Hospital.

Bill explained that about 15 years ago, St. Luke's Board of Trustees chose to partner with Carolinas Medical Center to improve the services available at our hospital. Because of this partnership, we have seen a dramatic improvement in services available to residents of Polk County. The contract for the partnership will be ending soon, and the Carolinas Medical Center has decided they are no longer interested in partnering with small hospitals like St. Luke's.

The Board of Trustees and hospital staff have been looking for another partner that will allow St. Luke's Hospital to provide the excellent level of care for which they are known. The Trustees, in partnership with the Polk County Board of Commissioners, have chosen Advent Health as their new partner. The new agreement will be finalized in the Fall.

Rotarians expressed their thanks to Bill and the other Trustees for ensuring we maintain a hospital in our community. We are looking forward to seeing what this new partnership brings to our local hospital.
