

Fehl Shares YMCA Success

YMCA District Executive Director Atticus Fehl presented information about YMCA summer camp in Polk County. Summer Day Camp was offered at Tryon Elementary and Polk Central Elementary Schools, serving a total of 177 rising K5 - 8th graders and Counselors in Training, ages 13 - 15.



The camps featured swimming and swimming lessons three times a week at Gibson Park Pool, organized outdoor activities and games, service learning projects, Art and Academic Enrichment with certified teachers twice a week and weekly field trips. 70% of the children received financial assistance, thanks to donations from local individuals and organizations, including the Parsec Fund at Polk County Community Foundation. Atticus said, "Camp is where strangers become friends and friendships last a lifetime!"



He concluded with a brief Capital Campaign update, announcing the new facility will be named the *Geoff and Alice Tennant YMCA of Polk County*.

To date, \$3,074,191 has been raised, \$301,200 of which was committed by **Rotary Club of Tryon** and its members, and an additional \$946,501 was secured by **Rotary Club of Tryon** members, bringing the **Rotary Club of Tryon's** total involvement to 40% of the total committed!
