TRIFF Poster Winner Cori Anna Klepac



The Rotary Club of Tryon was excited to have Garland Rice demonstrate his dowsing ability at a recent meeting. Garland learned to dowse when he wanted to install a well on his property.



When the two dowsers he knew locally were not available, he received a little instruction and did it himself. To date, he has successfully identified sites for two wells. Although he can provide no "scientific" explanation for the phenomenon, he believes the rods react to the CHI (life force) in the water.



After his demonstration, many Rotarians gave dowsing a try and were successful.
