Are you looking for a way to increase your Rotary knowledge and strengthen your club and district experience? Register today for [Rotary Leadership Institute \(RLI\)](#), which will be held Saturday, Nov. 9, in Asheville.



Rotary provides an opportunity for all of us to provide service to our community and throughout the world. (Service Above Self) With that service comes a learning experience in the areas of leadership, team building, planning, marketing, communication and organization. RLI provides an opportunity to enrich that learning through sharing experiences and ideas with other Rotarians throughout the region.

The program consists of three separate sessions: Part I, Part II and Part III. Attendees progress through the three parts on separate days and complete the program at their own pace. Each session is highly interactive and contains a minimum of lecturing. There are lots of opportunity for participants to share their experience and ideas. The sessions are led by Rotary leaders who have been trained in the facilitation techniques that maximize the learning experience.

Rotary District 7670 is hosting the event on Saturday, November 9, at the Asheville campus of Montreat College, but attendees and faculty will be from all over the Southeast, so we want to have great representation of our #SouthernFriedRotary! We even have a small amount of money in the district budget this year to reimburse members who complete one of the courses! The cost to attend is \$95 and includes breakfast, lunch and all materials.
