To encourage giving to The Rotary Foundation and help you achieve the next level of giving recognition, the Rotary Club of Charlotte-South will match each dollar our members* donate to The Rotary Foundation between December 15, 2018 and March 31, 2019 with one Foundation recognition point, up to 500 points.

The Paul Harris Fellow recognition acknowledges individuals who contribute, or who have contributions made in their name, of \$1,000 or more to The Rotary Foundation.

Donations made the Rotary Foundation support work in Rotary's six areas of focus: promoting peace, fighting disease, providing clean water, saving mothers and children, supporting education, and growing local economies around the world.

ABOUT THE PAUL HARRIS SOCIETY

The Paul Harris Society is distinct from Paul Harris Fellow recognition. A Paul Harris Fellow has made cumulative contributions of at least \$1,000, or has had that amount contributed in his or her name, while a member of the Paul Harris Society has committed to contributing at least \$1,000 each year.

- Educate communities about how to support LGBTQ-identified youth
- Provide opportunities for food-insecure children to learn about nutrition and culinary skills
- Elevate the voices of young people around issues of school safety
- Create meaningful connections between homeless youth and the metro Charlotte community
- Increase access to materials to promote college-readiness amongst at-risk high school students
- Support K-12 teachers in creating more empathetic classroom environments
- Collect essential food items for struggling communities in Venezuela
- Reduce the impact of carbon emissions by planting Urban Orchards

Since 2012 and as of July 2018, 65 climbers, mostly Rotarians from our District, have climbed to the top of Mt. Kilimanjaro in Tanzania and raised over \$175,000 for the PolioPlus fund at The Rotary Foundation. Much of this has

been matched 2:1 by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.
