Craig Horn is the Mayor of the Town of Weddington. He will share the challenges faced by Weddington Municipal Government and the similarities of other local municipalities, including Charlotte.

Prior to serving as the Mayor, he was elected to the North Carolina General Assembly in 2010 as Representative, District 68, Union County, NC, and retired at the end of 2020.

He spent 35 years in the food industry, including 25 years as founding partner in one of largest foodservice brokerage companies in the USA.

Served 7 1/2 years in the USAF Security Service, 1962-69, as a Russian Linguist on 2 overseas tours

President of the Churchill Society of North Carolina and member of the operating Board of The International Churchill Society, an international organization that promotes the study of leadership & statesmanship thru the life of Winston S. Churchill.


We packed 10,150 meals for Rise Against Hunger - WOW!
