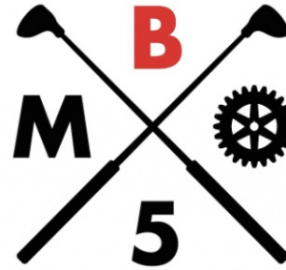

He realizes how weak he is, so he is happy to try to walk and get his energy back. He says clear and concise words, but sometimes they don't necessarily connect. He does get his point across, even if it is not perfect grammatically.

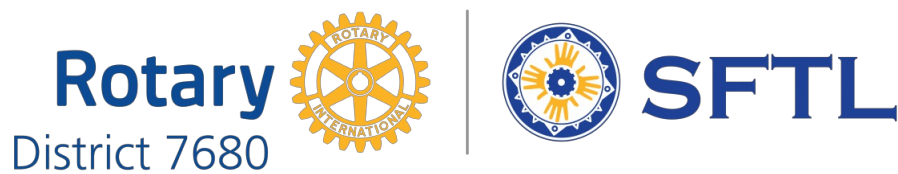
