Hi [NAME], as you may recall, my Rotary club runs an annual golf charity event that raises money for [Beds For Kids of Charlotte](#) and the [Meck South Rotary club](#). The event is called **Bloody Marys on Five (BMOF)**, and I would love your help in making introductions to possible sponsors by forwarding this email to them.

This year's event is held on **September 30 at the Longview Country Club in Charlotte**. All the event details, including available sponsorship packages, can be found on the **event website www.bmo5.com**.

BMOF is truly the **world's most ridiculously awesome golf tournament**. How do I know that? Well, every year we have 56 regular player spots and 88 player spots for our sponsors. It is our **10th anniversary year**, we have already sold all 56 player spots, we have people waitlisted, and all that before official registration began on Monday, June 3rd. **YES, the event is THAT awesome**. So, the only way to still get a player spot in this event is **SPONSORSHIPS**.

The event is so popular, because our main focus is the **player and sponsor experience** ([pictures from last year](#)).
