December 1 - Dr. Katie Passaretti with Atrium Health - How the pandemic changed healthcare



Dr. Passaretti completed college, medical school, Internal Medicine Residency and Infectious Disease Fellowship at Johns Hopkins. She worked as the hospital epidemiologist at Johns Hopkins Bayview before transitioning to Atrium Health to become Medical Director of Infection Prevention in 2011. She currently is Vice President, Enterprise Chief Epidemiologist at Atrium Health and is currently an Associate Professor in Internal Medicine. Dr. Passaretti is a member of the Society of Healthcare Epidemiology of America and The Infectious Diseases Society of America. She has served as frequent news contributor for local and national news including MSNBC, CNN and Fox and has consulted with the US Court System and multiple universities on issues related to COVID, monkeypox and other infectious disease related topics.
