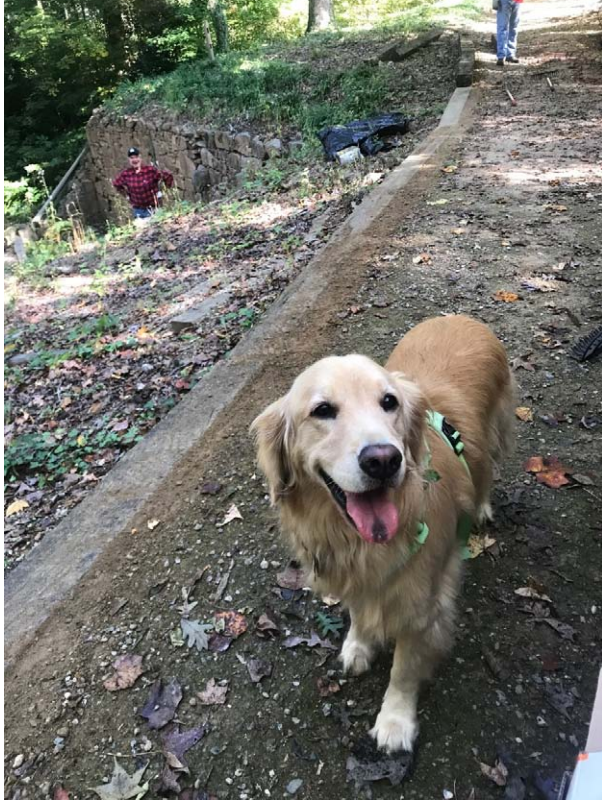
Grist Mill Clean Up

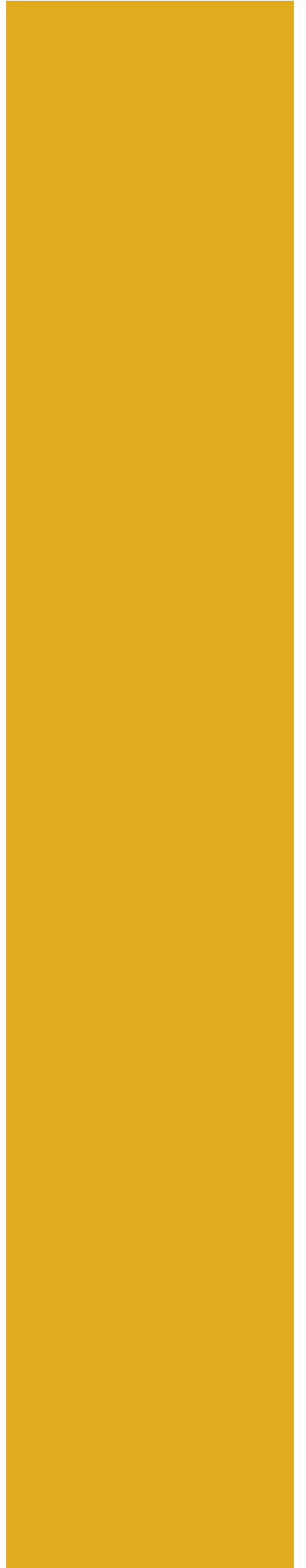
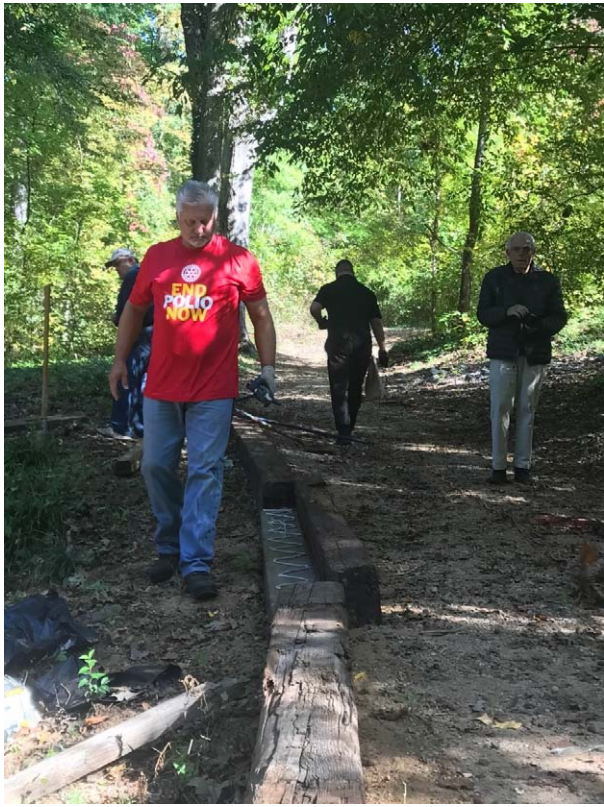
