Chris Peek, CaroMont Health Update



Join Chris Peek as he updates the group on CaroMont health system's major expansion projects, educational partnerships, and foundation work.

Chris Peek is the President and Chief Executive Officer of CaroMont Health. In this role, Peek leads a regional healthcare system comprised of CaroMont Regional Medical Center, a 435-bed acute care hospital; CaroMont Medical Group, a network of more than 55 primary and specialty care physician offices; Courtland Terrace, a 96-bed skilled nursing facility; and Gaston Hospice, a robust hospice and palliative care organization.

Peek serves on several community nonprofit boards, including the Boys and Girls Clubs of Greater Gaston, the Gaston Business Association and the Community Foundation of Gaston County, and is a member of the Board of Trustees for the North Carolina Healthcare Association.

A 30-year resident of Gaston County, Peek is an honors graduate from the University of North Carolina at Charlotte Belk College of Business and holds a Master of Business Administration from Amberton University. Peek is a certified lean six-sigma executive champion and holds a strategic executive designation from Cornell University. Recognized for innovative leadership, Peek was named to the Business North Carolina Power List in 2021 and 2022, and the Charlotte Business Journal Power 100 List for 2022.

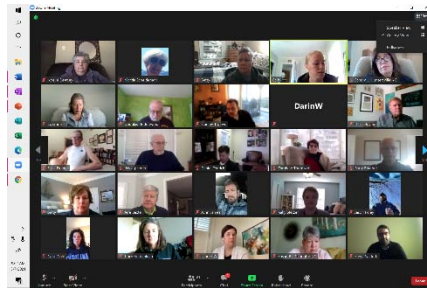
