Weekly Program - Stanly Adult Care Center (SACC) - Sandy Carelock Ex. Dir.

- The Goal of the SACC is to allow community members to age in place at home for as long as possible
- Adult Day Centers provide peace of mind and respite care for care givers
- 55 out of 100 counties in NC have adult day services and SACC will bring that to Stanly County
- The SACC was incorporated in December 2021
- SACC purchased an old child care center to be renovated
- Services will be provided Monday to Friday form 6:45am to 6:00pm
- There will be a therapeutic kitchen, various activities, a therapy room, transportation, personal care services, meals and snacks, a beauty shop and a social program
- 40 people per day will be able to receive services
- Adult Day Care is the lowest costing form of senior care (expected to be \$70-\$74 per day)
- The goal is to be operational by January 1 2025
