He also served as educational consultant with the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction for four years. He is a member of the College Board's Superintendents Advisory Council, made up of approximately 30 superintendents across the country who share ideas and best practices about educational improvement.

I am excited to announce that Homes For Our Troops is near completion of his custom home, right in your community!

Homes For Our Troops (HFOT) is a privately funded 501(c) (3) nonprofit organization that builds and donates specially adapted, custom homes nationwide for severely injured post 9/11 Veterans. Veterans choose the community where they wish to focus on recovery, and rebuilding their lives. Since inception in 2004, HFOT has built more than 330 homes in 42 states, with an additional 82 projects underway!

Following a 30-year career in destination marketing including leading visitor bureaus in Asheville, Chapel Hill, and Durham, NC, Shelly retired from Discover Durham in the fall of 2019. With more than three decades of experience spanning the public, private and nonprofit sectors she launched a consulting business that same year to assist tourism organizations with strategic planning, organizational effectiveness, policy development and governance.

During her tenure in Durham, she oversaw the organization's accreditation and re-accreditation process earning 26 exemplary citations for best practices. She oversaw the creation of a new visitor information center or Main Street, and help found the Durham Sports Commission and managed it through its startup phase.

She has produced long-term strategic and destination management plans and organizational reviews for organizations such as Daytona Beach, Lake Placid, Outer Banks, and Nassau/Paradise Island. Shelly has served in many leadership roles in the tourism and nonprofit sectors, as well as those that serve her local community. In recognition of her service and accomplishments Shelly was recently inducted into the Destinations International Hall of Fame.
