BEVERLEY BOITUMELO MAKHUBELE

Beverley Boitumelo Makhubele is an Indigenous Southern African and curious student of humans - human ambitions and interactions; human inclination and predisposition. Their study is best articulated through their passion for exploring and engineering spaces that bring humans together. Sometimes those spaces are businesses - two of them are located in the Driver/Angier corridor of East Durham. Rofhiwa Book Cafe is a living room and communal space disguised as an independent bookstore and coffee shop. Rofhiwa's curated selections feature classic and contemporary works by Black writers across the globe. Through their work with Rofhiwa, they have been a 2023 Finalist for the Charlotte Hornets Innovation Summit and winner of the inaugural Pharell Williams Black Ambition Prize.

Just up the street, inspired by South African traditions of sociality and gathering, Congress Social Bar opened in August 2023. Congress - East Durham's only neighborhood bar - is an easy-going hangout place for everyday people who are curious about the project of being human together.

Beverley is a long-time human, resident of East Durham, and alumna of the illustrious North Carolina A&T where they studied Computer Science and Architectural Engineering. A serially-interested entrepreneur, they are particularly interested in projects that explore Black economic potential, promote participation in the markets, and extend the reach of Black legacy. Currently, they are working on a startup that encourages and makes it accessible for young millennials, particularly young millennials of color, to invest in real estate. They are also reviving an ancestral home in rural South Africa, a project through which they are interrogating how Black Southern African traditions of building, architecture, and homesteading can meet the modern moment.
