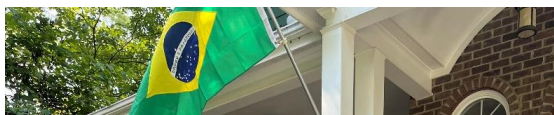
Today's Speaker - Author and Life Coach Orit Ramler

Rotary Club of Raleigh Forecast

Monday will be another warm and humid day with high temperatures in the upper 80s. However, drier air will begin to push into central NC throughout the day as a west wind increases to about 7mph in the afternoon. Overnight lows tonight will drop into the low to mid-60s. Tuesday high temperatures will be in the mid 80s. Wind will shift to the north on Tuesday bringing in cooler temperatures along with drier air. On Wednesday morning, we'll wake up to temperatures in the upper 50s. Wednesday through Friday will feel positively fall-like! High temperatures will struggle to climb out of the 70s with lows in the mid 50s. A warmer and more humid airmass will meander into the region on Saturday bringing a return to daytime temperatures in the mid-upper 80s.
