Disaster Relief Efforts for Hurricane Helene

The devastation from Helene in western NC is unimaginable. Many of us are trying to find the best ways to help our western neighbors. The disaster relief page for Rotary Zones 33/34 has been updated and can be found [HERE](#). Donations made on this page will be directed to a bank account owned by the two zones. Zones 33/34 are recognized as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, which means that it operates as a recognized charity. The plan is to collect donations through the website and assemble a team of experienced Rotary leaders to make recommendations about how to disperse the donations to create the maximum positive effect. The assembled team will also rely on Rotary leaders in the affected districts to determine the highest priorities in their areas and how to address them.
